- Youth Flower Arrangements 12-4 Saturday Sept 11 and Sunday, Sept. 12 for open youth department.
- Sept 11th 12-4 pm only will be eligible to enter in the 4-H youth department with floral arrangements

Requirements for flower arrangements:

- Size to be no larger than 20" overall Youth to work on-site between 12:00 and 4:00 PM, Saturday, September 11 and Sunday, September 12.
- They shall bring all materials needed to assemble their arrangements. Arrangements will be completed in the Floriculture Building with no assistance, in the presence of the clerks.
- Accessories: Sensible use of accessories permitted. Mats, stands and objects other than container and plant material are considered accessories. No artificial flowers may be used.
- No pre-registration required. Floral foam provided. Please be sure your arrangement is stable and will not tip over if accidentally brushed or touched.

New swine rule: No whips are allowed to be used during the swine show ring or sale ring. As a result of seeing an exhibitor beat the heck out of her hog with a whip at the 2019 fair, the fair staff has placed a new rule that hog whips will **NOT** be allowed in the swine show ring and sale ring. An exhibitor may use pig bats or crops, as well the old-school cane and PVC pipe. 2021-2022 4-H ENROLLMENT FEE PAYMENT:

- CASH/CHECK DISCOUNT Pay directly to your 4-H community club leader.
- **ON-LINE** *payment survey* system! Additional \$10 processing fee will apply for credit card transactions.

FIRST TIME 4-H YOUTH MEMBERSHIP (New 4-H membership)

- Paid within 30 days of registration =\$90
- If paid after 30 days of registration -see the payment schedule below for the month.

RETURNING YOUTH MEMBER ENROLLMENT FEE (cash/check discount)

- Early Clover Special: July 1st September 30th = \$90
- Fall Clover: October 1st November 30th = \$120
- Late Clover: Enrollment: December 1st to June 30th = \$140

RETURNING YOUTH MEMBER ENROLLMENT FEES (with credit card processing fee)

- Early Clover Special: July 1st September 30th = \$100
- Fall Clover:: October 1st November 30th = \$130
- Late Clover: December 1st to June 30th = \$150

NEW & RETURNING ADULT LEADERS ENROLLMENT FEE:

- Cash/check discount schedule:
 - Early Bird Special: August 15th September 30th = \$35
 - Regular: October 1st November 30th = \$40
 - Late Enrollment: December 1st to June 30th = \$45

- Credit Card Payment processing fee and enrollment fees
 - \circ Early Bird Special: August 15th September 30th = \$45
 - Regular: October 1st November 30th = \$50
 - Late Enrollment: December 1st to June 30th = \$55

Fee waiver assistance is available for families to cover the 4-H enrollment in financial need. A family will need to complete the 4-H fee waiver form. After completing the 4-H fee waiver form, turn it in to your 4-H community club leader or 4-H office staff.

Just a reminder to all youth, parents, and leaders. A 4-H member needs to be in good standing to be eligible to show livestock at the county fairs and state fairs! A member in good standing is current 4-H enrollment, 4-H registration paid, minimum of 6 hours completed in the project plus 80% of the additional meeting required by the project leader, members APR (Annual Project Report) completed.
